### Trentadue, Alexander Valley, Ca

Trentadue is one of the wineries that Carole and I visited during our trip to the Napa and Sonoma Valleys last year. Their Petite Sirah as well as their Cuvee 32 were brought into the Wilmington market at our request since the Petite Sirah is one of our favorites and after tasting the Cuvee 32 in California I thought that it was a winner as well. The winery was started in 1959 when Leo and Evelyn Trentadue decided to pull up their Santa Clara County roots and head north. They settled on a ranch with 150 acres of plum trees and 60 acres of Zinfandel, Petite Sirah and Carignan vines. Today, with those original vines still producing excellent fruit, three generations of the Trentadue family work together to create the best wines possible from their 225 acre Alexander Valley Estate.

- **LA STORIA 2006 PITITE SIRAH (Regular Price: \$31.99 – Sale Price: \$23.99)** – La Storia is the reserve line for Trentadue with these wines being produced from the best grapes that the estate has to offer. Their Petite Sirah is one of my favorite wines and I have enjoyed several vintages over the course of the years that I have owned our wine shop. This wine is a big, delicious and wonderfully balanced treat. Too many California Petites are brash examples that knock you around with huge oak and favors that are out of control. This wine holds everything in perfect harmony, with just the right amount of intensity – and softness. Flavors are authentic and delicious, and the aromas practically leap from the glass. The more you swirl, the better the fruit aromas – and the softer the feel becomes. Personally I enjoy this wine with powerful potted meats such as Braised Veal Shenks (Osso Buco), but one person who has tried this wine with homemade chocolate chip cookies thinks that this pairing is outstanding!
- **LA STORIA 2009 CUVEE 32 (Regular Price: \$28.50 – Sale Price: \$23.99)**  
– The 2009 Proprietary Red Cuvee 32 is a blend of 49% Sangiovese, 27% Merlot, 8% Montepulciano, 8% Malbec, 7% Petite Sirah, and 1% Syrah. Spicy, earthy aromas of leather, berry fruit, pepper are followed by the food friendly acidity of the Sangiovese and the firm and juicy structure of the Merlot resulting into a rich, yet nicely balanced wine that exhibits layers of lush, sweet black fruit flavors.

### Belle Glos Winery, Rutherford, CA

- **Meiomi 2008 Pinot Noir (Regular Price: \$28.50 – Sale: \$18.00)** - Deep garnet color with aromas of strawberry, cherry and faint notes of spicy oak and vanilla. On the palate smooth layers of rich red currant and spice with light smoke, earth and leather flavors. A balanced, velvety texture and supple tannins carry the wine through to a lingering finish.

## Duckhorn Decoy, Napa Valley, CA

Decoy is the second label for the high-end Duckhorn Winery located in Napa Valley California. According to the winery, “the Decoy product line has taken an important place in the Duckhorn family of wines. With our reputation for delivering great quality at a remarkable price, Decoy has established a loyal following for its distinctive style, which emphasizes ready-upon-release wines that are capable of expressing their full charm and complexity in their youth.”

- **2008 PRIORITY RED (Regular Price: \$29.99 – Sale Price: \$23.94)** - “The 2008 vintage has yielded a broad and inviting expression of our Decoy Red Wine, with classic Napa Valley fruit notes and a silky, mouthcoating mid-palate. The aromas spotlight layers of mocha, mulberry and cassis with a subtle, yet sophisticated hint of cigar box. On the palate, this wine is soft and appealing with abundant flavors of blackcurrant, plum, hazelnut and licorice.” – Winemakers Notes
- **2008 PINOT NOIR, ANDERSON VALLEY, CA (Regular Price: \$26.99 – Sale Price: \$20.99)** - “The aromas offer enticing layers of Bing cherry, anise, cola, mint and oak-inspired vanilla. On the palate, the wine displays lovely weight and balance with rich and appealing layers of raspberry, fresh strawberry pie, Santa Rosa plum and morel mushroom, all underscored by a streak of acidity that carries the flavors to a long, satisfying finish..” – Winemakers Notes
- **2008 CABERNET SAUVIGNON (Regular Price: \$29.99 – Sale Price: \$23.94)** - “Decoy Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon offers a rich and appealing expression of Cabernet crafted to be ready upon release. Aromas of blackberry, boysenberry, cigar box, toffee and mint lead to fresh dark berry and red currant flavors and hints of dried herbs. The palate is soft and inviting, and the finish offers lingering notes of fruit, caramel and almond.” – Winemakers Notes

## Silver Palm Winery, California

- **2008 NORTH COAST CABERNET SAUVIGNON (Regular Price: \$21.99 – Sale Price: \$15.99)** - The 2008 vintage of Silver Palm has aromas of dark chocolate, cherry, black pepper and a bit of smoke from its oak aging. Intense flavors of black currant and blackberry on the palate, enriched by espresso, cocoa and vanilla tones from 10 months’ aging in 72% French and 28% American oak barrels. Rich tannins lead to a silky, lingering finish that makes this wine an ideal companion to grilled and broiled meats.

## Zenato Azienda, Delle Venezie, Italy

- **2009 PINOT GRIGIO (Regular Price: \$14.99 – Sale Price: \$11.99)** - Straw yellow in color with greenish highlights, and a delicate bouquet. This is a wine to be enjoyed young when one can best appreciate its zesty fruitiness. Refreshing and soft with a smooth, dry finish, this versatile Pinot Grigio is a great choice for any occasion, but ideal with hors d'ouvres, soups and fish
